(iii) Powers delegated under section 17 shall be exercisable in respect of the relevant provisions specified in column (2) ; and (iv) The Provincial Environmental Protection Agencies in the Provinces of Sindh and Balochistan shall be in charge of the matters related to land-based pollution and its effect on maritime resources ; and shall also co-ordinate with the Maritime Security Agency, the Pakistan Environmental Protection Agency and other concerned institutions in this regard.
